A brief history of NAPA Auto Parts in Lake City - Willard and Alice Wintheiser came to Lake City in the early 1960s. Willard approached the bank with idea of opening a NAPA Auto Parts store and was refused - "too much inventory", he was told. But in 1962, with the help of relatives, he opened Wintheiser Auto Supply, Lake City's first NAPA Auto Parts store.

Willard, Alice, and their son, Charles (Chuck) took care of the community with their auto and ag parts store. Eleven years later, Chuck and his wife purchased the business. Chuck and his family ran the store from September 1973 until September 2007 - 34 years

In 1997 they moved the store from the downtown storefront that currently houses Kemp Real Estate, to the current location of Lyon Avenue.

In September of 2007, Chuck sold Wintheiser Auto Supply to longtime employee Lloyd York. Lloyd continues to serve the local automotive needs today.
